

J. Robert Warren - memorandum the 15th by James Shirley his attorney sued out his Lordships writ of attachment ag.  
David Olford Esq. of Humphry Hughes - the deft the tenor whereof followeth in these words vizt.

Somerset County J. Charles absolute Lord and proprietor of the provinces of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore Esq. To the Sher. of Somerset County greeting we Command you that you attach any the Goods and Chattels Rights or Credits of Humphry Hughes Late of Somerset County planter if they shall be found in your Bailiwick to the value of Six hundred pounds of Tobacco and when you have the same attached on any part thereof the same in your custody safe keep so that you have the same before our Justices of our County Court of Somerset to be hold at dividing next the third tuesday of march next then and thers to be condemned according to Law to and for the Use of a certain Robert Warren unless the said Humphry by himself or his attorney shall appear and answer unto the said Robert Warren in plea of trespass upon the Case &c. according to Law and that by Gods and Law full means of your Bailiwick you make known unto the person or persons in whose hands you make the same Attachment that he she or they he and appear before the Justices of our County Court to be hold as aforesaid to show cause if any he she or they have why the same Good Chattels Rights or Credits so attached in his her hands or their hands ought not to be condemned and Execution thereof had and made according to the form of the act of asembly in such case made and provided if to him her or them it shall seem meet and also you shall execute this Will that you make known unto our said Justices at the day & place aforesaid and have you then and there this Will witnessed Wm Blannor Gent. one of our Justices of our said Court the twenty fourth day of November in the sixth year of our Sovereign King and Queen their hundred & thirty

att which said third tuesday of march to wit the sixteenth day of the same month being the day of the Return of said Writ Quid Dowd. One thousand Seven hundred and thirty five of the said Robert Warren by his attorney aforesaid and the Sher. of Somerset County to whom the foregoing Writ was directed Likewise find and make Return thereof to the Court her end or to wit - To the Worshipfull Justices within mentioned I Certifie that I have attached in the hands of David Olford one hundred and thirty pounds of Tobacco as of the Right and Credits of the within named Humphry Hughes and further I Certifie that by Charles Frankliffe Isaac Marshall Esq. and Lawfull men of my Bailiwick I have made known unto the said David Olford that he be and appear at that time and place within Contained to show &c. as by the within precept I am Commanded - John Burrall Sher.

Whereupon the said Robert Warren by his attorney prays that the said Sum of one hundred and thirty pounds of Tobacco so as aforesaid attached in the hands of the aforesaid David Olford as of the Right and Credits of the said Humphry Hughes may be condemned in the hands of the said David Olford towards Satisfying unto the said Robert Warren his damages and Costs and all Costs accruing upon the writ of attachment afo. Whereupon the said David Olford at his solemnly called Come not but makes default

Therefore it is foundered by the Court that the aforesaid Sum of one hundred and thirty pounds of Tobacco so as aforesaid attached be condemned in the hands of the aforesaid David Olford as of the Right and Credits of the said Humphry Hughes towards Satisfying unto the said Robert Warren his damages and Costs and all Costs accruing upon the writ of attachment afo. and that the said Humphry have the said Execution against the said David Olford according to act of asembly &c.

J. P. Esq. John Innes - This being an action of trespass upon the Case &c. wherein the Sher. of Somerset County to whom the writ in the same action was directed Comes and makes Return thereof to the Court her end or to wit - I Certifie that I have attached in the hands of the said David Olford one hundred and thirty pounds of Tobacco as of the Right and Credits of the within named Humphry Hughes and further I Certifie that by Charles Frankliffe Isaac Marshall Esq. and Lawfull men of my Bailiwick I have made known unto the said David Olford that he be and appear at that time and place within Contained to show &c. as by the within precept I am Commanded - John Burrall Sher. Whereupon the said Dominick Danvers Esq. appears and prays that the said John Innes may give Security for Costs in Case reverse be obtained against him in the plea aforesaid which is by the Court granted Whereupon Lord Hale of Somerset County Esq. gives out his own Court in his proper person under the
