said Aaron in consideration thereof afterwards to wit the same day and year aforesaid at the County  
aforesaid and within the aforesaid Jurisdiction upon himself assumed and to the said Walter then and there  
faithfully did Promise that when afterwards he should be hereunto requested by the aforesaid sum-  
of three thousand five hundred foot of plank the same Walter would well and faithfully Content
