Somerset p. Charles absolute Lord and propriety of the provinces of Maryland and Avalon Lord
 Baron of Baltimore &c To the Sheriff of Somerset County greeting we Command you -
 that you attach any the goods, Chattells Rights or Credits of Owen Owens Late of
 Somerset County Lordwainer if they shall be found in your Bailly wick to the value of
 Six pound, two Shilling and four pence Current money and two hundred and
 fifty pound of Tobacco and when you have the same attached or any part there of
 to the same in your Custody safe keep so that you have them before our Justices of
 our County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the third tuesday of
 March next then and there to be condemned according to act of Assembly to and
 for the use of a certain John Dennis Junr if the said Owen Owens by himselfe or
 his attorney shall appear and answer unto the said John Dennis in a plea
 of respas upon the Case &c according to Law and that by good and Lawfull
 men of your Bailly wick you make known unto the person or persons in whose
 hand, you make the same attachment that he she or they and appear before our Justices
 of our County Court to be held as aforesaid to show Cause if any he she or they have why the
 same Goods Chattells Rights or Credits so attached in his her or thure hand, ought
 not to be condemned and Execution there of had and made according to the forme of
 the Act of Assembly in such Case made and provided if to him her or them it shall
 seem meet and how you shall Execute this will that you make known unto our said
 Justices at the day and place aforesaid and have you then and there this writ to illnes
 William Plannr Gent^l one of our Justices of our said Court w twenty fourth day of
 November in the Sixteenth Year of our Dominion &c and Dow. One thousand Seven hundred and thirty

At which said third tuesday of March to wit the Sixteenth day of the same month anno. Dow. One thousand Seven
