Somerset & Charles absolute Lord and Proprietor of the provinces of many land and aavalon Lord Baron of Baltimore &c To the Shro. of Somerset County Greeting whereas Joseph Muffler lately in Our County Court of Somerset here to witt the Seventeenth day of June anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and twenty Nine before Samuel Hopkins Gent. and his associates then Justices of Our said Court at Dividing Creek by Consideration of the same Court Recovered against Hannah Horsey and John Horsey both late of Somerset County planters two thousand and forty one pounds of tobacco for his damages which he sustained by reason of certain promise and exemption to the same Joseph Muffler by the aforesaid Hannah and John Horseys lately made and not performed whereof they are bound as by the Records & proceeding sheweth in Our same Court before our Justices at Dividing Creek Remaining manifestly appeareth nevertoleft Execution of the judgment aforesaid as yet remaneth to be made as by the Jurisdiction of the said Joseph Muffler we have recovered and because we are willing that those things which in same Court are rightfully aited ought to be duly executed we command you that by Honest and Lawfull men of your baily — will you make known unto the said Hannah and John Horseys that they be before Our Justice of Our County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of March next to these cause if any thing for themselves they have or to say know wherefore the aforesaid Joseph Muffler his Execution of the judgment aforesaid to have ought not according to the form of the recovery aforesaid to them it shall seeme expedient and have you there and there the names of them by whom to them you make the same known and this will — Willm W^m Plummer Gent^m One of Our Justices of Our said Court the twenty fourth day of November in the Fifteenth year of Our dominion & anno Domini One thousand seven hundred & thirty

At which said next Court to wit the Sixteenth day of March anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and thirty being the day of the returne of the said Writ Cometh the said Joseph Muffler by his attorney aforesaid and the Shro. of Somerset County to wit John Burnside Esq^r. at the same day returned that he by virtue of the writ aforesaid to him directed he had made known to the aforesaid Hannah and John Horseys by Jacob Hindman and John Doe Honest and Lawfull men of his baily will that they be before His Lordships Justices at the day and place aforesaid to these g^t o^r as to him it was commanded, and the aforesaid Hannah and John Horseys so warned and at the same day being solemnly called Comette not but marked default
