condemned in the hands of the said Edmond Hough as of the Rights and Credits of the said Owen Owen towards  
Satisfying unto the said John Dennis as well the said sum of six pounds two shillings and four pence curr.  
money and two hundred and fifty pounds of tobacco as also all costs accruing upon the writ of attachment aforesaid  
and that the said John Dennis have thereof his Execution against the said Edmond Hough according to act of

Memorandum The selfs by Lewis Gal his attorney sued out his Lordships writ of Perpetuities  
against the selfs the tenor whereof followeth in these words viz --

Pomerset s. Charles absolute Lord and Proprietary of the provinces of Maryland  
& Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore &c. To the Sher. of Somerset County Greeting whereas Joseph M<sup>r</sup> Mester  
lately in our County Court of Somerset here to wit the Seventeenth day of June and Doin One thousand Seven  
hundred and twenty Nine before Samuel Hopkins Esq. and his associates then Justices of our said Court at  
Dividing Creek by consideration of the same Court Recovered against Hannah Horsey and John Horsey both  
late of Somerset County planters two thousand and forty one pounds of tobacco for his Damages which he  
Sustained by Breach of certain promise and assumption to the same Joseph M<sup>r</sup> Mester by the aforesaid  
Hannah and John Horsey lately made and not performed whereof they are convicted as by the Records &  
proceeding thereof in our same Court before our Justice at Dividing Creek remaining manifestly appeareth  
nevertheless Execution of the Judgment aforesaid as yet Remained to be made as by the Jurisdiction of the said  
Joseph M<sup>r</sup> Mester we have Received and because we are willing that those things which in same Court are right  
fully acted ought to be duly executed we Command you that by Honor and Lawfull men of your bailly  
with you made known unto the said Hannah and John Horseys that they be before our Justice of our  
County Court of Somerset to be hold at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of March next to show Cause if any  
thing for themselves they have or to say know wherefore the said Joseph M<sup>r</sup> Mester his Execution of the Judgment  
aforesaid to have ought not according to the force of the recovery aforesaid to them it shall seem Expedient and  
have you then and there the Names of them by whom to them you make the same known and this will --  
Witness W<sup>m</sup> Plummer Gent<sup>l</sup> one of our Justices of our said Court the twenty fourth day of November in the  
Sixteenth Year of our Dominion &c Anno Doin One thousand Seven hundred & thirty

At which said next Court to wit the Sixteenth day of March anno Doin. One thousand Seven  
hundred and thirty being the day of the Return of the said writ Cometh the said Joseph M<sup>r</sup> Mester by  
his attorney aforesaid and the Sher. of Somerset County to wit John Burnall Esq. at the same day  
returned that he by virtue of the writ aforesaid to him directed he had made known to the said Hannah and John  
Horsey by Jacob Hindman and John Doe Honor and Lawfull men of his bailly with that they be  
before his Lordships Justice at the day and place aforesaid to them &c as to him it was Comanded, and the  
said Hannah and John Horseys so warned and at the same day being solemnly called Cometh not  
but makes default -- Therefore it is considered that the said Joseph M<sup>r</sup> Mester have  
Execution
