Personally appeared before me the Subscriber one of his Lordships
 Justices of the County of Somerset the above named William Turvill and Elias Evans and made oath upon the Holy
 Evangelist of Allmightie God that the above account as it stands stated is just and true and that they
 nor either of them hath received any part or part of the same more than credit given nor any body for
 them and that the said Humphry Huay hath not any account against them or either of them to
 Discount against the above sum of Six pounds fifteen Shillings and Eleven pence
 Sworn before me William Gascoigne

A copy of the foregoing declaration and account were made and sent to be left at the Court
 place of the abode of the defendant.

All which said kind writ was made to wit the Sixteenth day of the same month and read one
 thousand seven hundred and thirty being the day of the return of the said writ unto the said William Turvill
 and Elias Evans by their attorney aforesaid and the Just. of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writ was
 directed Likewise read and made the return thereto of the said writ as is contained in these words following vizt

Nowest Duobus declaration Left of John Sunstall J^r

Whereupon the said William Turvill & Elias Evans by their attorney aforesaid pray that for as much
 as they have complied with the Law in order to an attachment they may have judgment against
 the said Humphry Huay for their damages and by way of attachment awarding that of a penalty
 of 50^s whereupon for that it seems to the Court here that the said William Turvill & Elias Evans
 have complied with the Law as alleged

Therefore it is considered by the Court here that the said William Turvill and Elias Evans recover
 against the aforesaid Humphry Huay Six pounds fifteen Shillings and Eleven pence and money then due
 by reason of the premises and all costs and charges by the said plaintiffs laid out and expended about
 his suit by way of attachment against the goods Chattels Rights or Credits of the said Humphry Huay
 and awarding to all of a penalty in such case made and provided by

 for fifty two pounds five Shillings and four pence and money as aforesaid proved with the
 Incident Costs and Charges according to the form of the Act of a penalty in such case lately
 made and provided and for your so doing this shall be your warrant as will be my hand
 and
