Chattels rights or Credits of George Martin Sale of Powerset County Merchant if they shall
be found in your Bailiwick to the value of fifty two pounds five Shillings and four
pence Current money and One thousand pounds of Tobacco and when you have the same
Attached on any part thereof the same in your Custody safe keep so that you have the
same before our Justices of our County Court of Powerset to be held at Dividing Creek the third
Tuesday of March Next then and there to be condemned according to Act of Assembly to
and for the Use of a certain John Sunstall unless the said George Martin by himself
or his Attorney shall appear and answer unto the said John Sunstall in a place of
his own upon the Case & according to Law and that by good and Lawfull men of
your Bailiwick you make known unto the person or persons in whose hands you
make the same Attachment that he. she or they be and appear before our Justices
of our County Court to be held as aforesaid to shew Cause if any he. she or they have why
the same Goods Chattels rights or Credits so Attached in his. her or their hands ought
not to be condemned and Execution thereof had and made according to Act of Assembly
in such Case made and provided if to him. her or them it shall seem meet and how you
shall execute this Writ that you make known unto our said Justices at the day
and place aforesaid and have you then and there this Writ well read William Blamire
Genl: one of our Justices of our said Court the twenty fourth day of November in the
Seventeenth Year of our Dominion & Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and
thirty —

directed Likewise Cometh and maketh Return thereto to the Court here endorsed viz By virtue of the within
Writ to me directed I have attached as the Goods and Chattels of the within named George Martin to the
value of fifty two pounds five ^{and} four pence Curr. money and One thousand pounds of Tobacco
in the hands of Heber Whittingham, and Likewise in the hands of John Sunstall twenty five pounds
Current money, and by Hugh Porter and John Doghouse and Lawfull men of my Bailiwick I have
made known to the said Heber Whittingham and John Sunstall that they be and appear at
the time and place within contained to shew Cause &c. as by the within Writ I am commanded so answers
John Sunstall

Whereupon the said John Sunstall by his attorney aforesaid prays that the aforesaid Sum of
twenty five pounds Curr. money so as aforesaid attached in his hands of the Rights and Credits of the said Geo.
Martin may be returned in his hands, towards Satisfying unto him the aforesaid Sum of fifty two pounds five
Shillings and four pence Current money and One thousand pounds of Tobacco as also all Costs accruing
upon the Writ of Attachment aforesaid.
Therefore it is considered by the said Court here that the aforesaid Sum of twenty five pounds Current money
so as aforesaid attached as aforesaid Rights and Credits of the said George Martin may be returned in the hands
of the said John Sunstall towards Satisfying unto him the aforesaid Sum of fifty two pounds five Shillings &
four pence Curr. money & One thousand pounds of Tobacco & all Costs accruing upon the Writ of Attachm^t.
