

Lt. Joseph Maulester } Command was Given to the Sher. of Somerset County that he should take the said William
 William Hopkins - } Hopkins late of Somerset County prisoner if he should be found in his bailly work and him should safe
 keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset to be had
 at dividing Creek the third Wednesday of March then next to answer unto Joseph Maulester of a plea of trespass upon the Case
 and that Whosoever should not fail to do.

And the said Joseph Maulester by Levi Gale his attorney Complain'd against the aforesaid William
 Hopkins in the plea aforesaid as follows to wit:

Somerset s. William Hopkins late of Somerset County Debtor was attached to answer unto Joseph Maulester
 of a plea of trespass upon the Case to wit:

And whereupon the said Joseph by Levi Gale his attorney Complain'd that whereas the said William
 the second day of May anno Domini Seventeen hundred and twenty nine at Somerset County aforesaid within the Juris-
 diction of this Court was indebted unto the said Joseph in four hundred and twenty nine pounds of tobacco as by his certain
 note hereunto produced may appear and being so indebted the said William in consideration thereof the day
 and year aforesaid at the County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction aforesaid upon himself did assume and to the
 said Joseph then and there did faithfully promise that he the said William the aforesaid four hundred and twenty
 nine pounds of tobacco when he should be therunto requested he would well and faithfully pay and content
 and fraudulently intending the said Joseph in that part craftily and subtilly to deceive and defraud the afo-
 said Joseph on the aforesaid second day of May in the year aforesaid and often afterwards he was therunto
 requested hath not paid or to him for the same in any sort contented but the same to him hitherto to pay or in any sort
 to content hath refused and still doth refuse and deny whereupon he saith he is worse and hath damage to the
 value of eight hundred ^{with eight} pounds of tobacco and thereupon he brings Suit Levi Gale Esq. Plaintiff. Defendant
 a copy of the writ of attachment was made and sent to be left at the last place of the abode of the Defendant.

At which said third Wednesday of March to wit the sixteenth day of the same month and anno Domini One thousand
 Seven hundred and thirty being the day of the return of the said writ Cometh the said Joseph Maulester by his
 attorney aforesaid and Sher. of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writ was directed Likewise Cometh and
 maketh Return thereto to the Court here endorsed in these words: viz. None of Duobus Short note left off

Whereupon the aforesaid Joseph Maulester by his attorney aforesaid prayeth that inasmuch as he hath
 Complied with the Law in order to an attachment he may have Judgment against the said William Hopkins
 by way of attachment for his damages and according to act of assembly to wit: Whosoever for that it seems to the
 Court here that the said Joseph Maulester has Complied with the Law as alleged

Therefore it is considered by the Court here that the aforesaid Joseph Maulester Recover
 against the said William Hopkins four hundred and twenty nine pounds of tobacco for his damages
 by reason of the premises aforesaid as all costs and charges by the said plaintiff the said Defendant
 expended about his Suit by way of attachment against the said Defendant's rights or credits of the
 said William Hopkins according to act of assembly in such case made and provided to do.
