And the aforesaid Benjamin Sharp by James Shirley his attorney comes and defendeth the force and injury where he and pray leave thereof to Imparte here unto until the next Court and he hath it and the same day is given to the aforesaid party hereto also her -

At which said next Court to wit the Seventeenth day of November and Dowd One thousand and Seven hundred and thirty came againe as well the aforesaid John Stewart as the aforesaid Benjamin Sharp by their attorneys aforesaid and wherupon the said Benjamin Sharp further leave herof to Imparte here unto the next Court and he had it and the same day is given to the aforesaid John hereto also her -

At which said next Court to wit the Sixteenth day of March and Dowd One thousand and Seven hundred and thirty came againe as well the aforesaid John Stewart as the aforesaid Benjamin Sharp by their attorneys aforesaid and wherupon the same Benjamin by his said attorney as before defendeth the force and injury where he and saith that he did not affirme upon himselfe in manner and form aforesaid the aforesaid John Stewart above against him hath declared and of this he putteth himselfe upon the country g^r and to plift in like manner -

Whereupon command is given to the Sherif of Somerset County that he immediately cause to come forth twelve Jurors who neither do to recognize he because as well he of which said preceipit the said Sherif to wit John Burnside Esq^r. You now have to wit the same day and year last mentioned make Return that he hath his ready twelve Jurors by his said preceipit power commanded and now hereafterwards to wit the same day and year came as well the aforesaid John as the aforesaid Benj^m by their attorneys aforesaid and the jurors of that Jury herein Impowered being called likewise came to wit James Rousard, William Jones, Thomas Rayley, Isaac Marshall, Edward Franklin, John Hollands, John Somersall, Robert Williams, Thomas Bellis, Daniel Boyce, James Houston, John Webb who being duly elected tryed and sworn to say the truth in the premises upon their oaths do say that the aforesaid Benjamin Sharp did not affirme upon himselfe in manner and form as the aforesaid John Stewart above against him hath complained he -

Wherefore it is considered that the aforesaid John Stewart take nothing by his writt and declaration aforesaid but be therof in mercy for his false Camour and that the said Benjamin Sharp go therof without day he and further it is considered that the aforesaid Benjamin Sharp recover against the said John Stewart Six hundred and Eighty seven - - - pounds of tobacco for his costs and charges by him about his defence in that part sustained to the same Benjamin by the said lord of his aforesaid adjudged according to the form of the Statute in such Case Lately made and provided and that the aforesaid Benj^m have therof payment & 687
