Errors Excepted of John Stewart

And the aforesaid James Lindow by James Shirley his attorney comes and defends the force and injury
 when he and pray Leave to impart his own unto unto the next Court and he hath it and the same day is given
 to the aforesaid John Stewart also &c.

At which said next Court to wit the Sixteenth day of March and D^{no} One thousand Seven hundred
 and thirty came again as well the aforesaid John Stewart as the aforesaid James Lindow by their attorneys -
 aforesaid and whereupon the said James Lindow by his said attorney as before defended the force and injury
 when he and faith that he did not assume upon himself in manner and form as the aforesaid John above
 against him hath complained and of this he putt himself upon the Country -

Whereupon the dispute in this action is by the Court and Consent of the parties referred to Thomas Dashiell John
 Donelson James Martin and Isaac Fleming all of Somerset County Gent^l or any three of them according to the
 Statute, and that Judgment be on the Return as of this Court, and afterwards to wit the same day and year
 aforesaid came Thomas Dashiell, John Donelson James Martin and Isaac Fleming the persons mentioned in the
 aforesaid Rule of Reference and makes Return of the Rule their award in the premises as followeth to wit -

That the Subscribers Chosen by Mr John Stewart and Capt James Lindow to settle their accounts depending
 between them do award that Capt James Lindow pay unto the aforesaid Stewart the Sum of Eleven pounds One
 Shilling and Eight pence Current money of Maryland which we do ad judge to be the balance due to said Stewart
 as witness our Hands. Tho^s Dashiell, John Donelson, James Martin & Isaac Fleming
 which being Read and heard - Therefore it is Commanded that the aforesaid John Stewart Recover against the aforesaid
 James Lindow the Sum of Eleven pounds One Shilling and Eight pence Current money his damages afo by the arbitra-
 rious afo found as also three hundred & Eighty Eight pounds of tobacco for his Costs
 and Charges to the said John Stewart by the Court hereof his agent adjudged and the afo James Lindow
 in money &c
