 of a plera of the ps upon the case and that there of he shold not fail.

All which said third leesday of November to witt the Seventeenth day of the same month and Bore One thousand
 Seven hundred and thirty four being the day of the return of the said writ came the said William Richards in his pro-
 per person and the Sheriff of somerset County to whom the foregoing writ was directed ^{Exegeze} and made
 return there of to the court here endorsed in these words following viz. Cxii. Cor. of John Burnell Psd.

And the said Robert Atkins by Francis Allen and James Shirley his attorney came and defend the same
 and injury whereof and pray leave therof to imparte his cause to the next Court and he had it and
 the same day is given to his aforesaid plera here also.

All which said next Court to witt the Sixteenth day of March and Bore One thousand Seven hundred
 and thirty came again the said Robert Atkins by his attorney aforesaid and offered himself against the
 aforesaid William Richards in the plea aforesaid but the said William alled. Solemly called come not, nor dole
 in his will aforesaid further prosecute him.

Therefore it is considered that he and his plegers of prosecuting be in money and that the sum
 of his plegers be sought for and that the aforesaid Robert Atkins pay hereof without day and also it is considered
 that the aforesaid Robert Atkins recover against the aforesaid William Richards his damages by reason of his premises
 155 to One hundred & fifty five pounds of tobacco by direction of the Justices
 here at his request for his costs and charges in that part sustained according to the form of the Statute or
 by the Justices adjudged him.
