 vs. Christopher Glap — Somerset County vs. Richard Barrimore Late of Somerset
 County Taylor was attached to answer unto Christopher Glap of a plea
 vs. Richard Barrimore of his part upon the case &c.

And whereupon the said Christopher by Francis Allen his attorney complains that
 whereas the said Richard the thirteenth day of August and Doin. Seventeen hundred and twenty
 nine at Somerset County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction of this Court was indebted unto the said Christo-
 pher in two pounds nine Shillings Current Money as by an account therunto annexed may in Court appear
 and being so therof indebted the said Richard in consideration thereof of the day and year aforesaid
 within the Jurisdiction aforesaid upon himself did assume and to the said Christopher then and there did faithfully
 promise to pay the said two pounds nine Shillings Current Money when he should be lawfully requested to do so faithfully
 pay and content. Nevertheless the said Richard his promise and assumption aforesaid in truth aforesaid made nothing
 regarding but plotting and fraudulently intending the said Christopher in that part craftily and
 Subtly to deceive and defraud the said two pounds nine Shillings to the said Christopher altho.
 the same to doe the said Richard by the said Christopher on the thirteenth day of August in the
 year aforesaid and often afterwards at the County aforesaid within the Jurisdiction aforesaid by the said Christo-
 pher he was therunto requested hath not paid or to him for the same in any sort Contented but
 the same to him hitherto to pay or in any sort to Content hath refused and still doth refuse
 and deny whereupon he hath he is worse and hath damage to the value of four pounds
 Eighteen Shillings Like money and thereupon he brings Suit &c.

And the said Richard Barrimore in his own person comes and defends the face &
 Injury when &c. and prays Leave to Impare his account until the next Court and he had it and
 the same day is given to the said Chris. Glap also &c.

At which said next Court to wit the thirteenth day March and Doin. One thousand Seven hundred and thirty
 came againe the said Christopher Glap by his attorney aforesaid and prays that the said Richard Barrimore to
 his declaration aforesaid may answer but the said Richard altho. solemnly called same not nor says
 nothing in bar or preclusion of the action aforesaid whereby the said Christopher remains against the
 said Richard therof undefended &c.

Wherefore the said Christopher his damages by reason of the non performance of the promise
 and assumption aforesaid against the said Richard ought to recover thereupon the Justice here at
 the prayer of the said Christopher and by the Consent of the said Richard according to act of
 assembly in such case made and provided aforesaid the damage of the said Christopher further
 than his Costs and Charges by him about his Suit in that part aforesaid to two pounds nine Shillings
 Current Money &c.

Therefore
