action he well and faithfully paid to the said Aaron Lynn five pounds Eleven shillings and four pence halfe penny
at Somerset County afo within the jurisdiction of this Court and as to the four pounds Three shillings and four pence
pence payed the residue of the debt in the said declaration specified the said Isajah further saith that he
afterwards to wit the same day and year aforesaid and before the commencement of his action William Robinson
