

Commorant was given to the sherrif of Somerset County that he should take Isajah Quaterman late of Somerset County planter ad. dit. Isac Gurnus of Somerset County is to be found in his Bayhuit and him should safe keep so that - might have his body before County Court of Somerset to be hold at Dwidrig Creek the thirunday of August next next of agelea that he render unto him fifteen pounds Eleven shillings and a penny furamy of 9 and unjustly detaines &c and that thereof he should not for do

And the said Aaron Lynn by Francis Allen his attorney declared against the afo plea as followeth vid - Somerset County for Isajah Quaterman late of Somerset County was summoned to answer unto Aaron Lynn of plea that he had Eleven shillings and a penny furamy of Maryland which to him & away and unjustly detaines

And Whorugon the said Aaron by Francis Allen his attorney saith that whorugon the 10 of february and said One thousand seven hundred and twenty eight nine at Somerset of this Court by his certain writing obligatory which the said Aaron Lynn with the deal of the afo brings the debt whorugon is the same day and year did deliver to the said Aaron Lynn fifteen pounds Eleven shillings and a penny furant money afo to be paid unto the said Aaron Lynn the said Isajah the 10th of August required the said Isajah hath not rendered but the same to him hitherto to render hath the said Aaron saith he is wove and hath damage to the do whorugon he brings this suit the 10th of february 1789

A copy of the foregoing declaration was made and sent to the said Isajah Quaterman at his dwelling house in the County of Somerset to wit the eighteenth day of the same month and thirly being the day of the return of the said writ by the said Aaron Lynn by his sherrif of Somerset County to whom to the foregoing writ is directed likewise by the said Court was returned in these words following vid - Isi Isajah Quaterman delivered in line

And the said Isajah Quaterman in his own proper person appears and whorugon the Isajah Quaterman at the Court of the plea by his attorney aforesaid is adjudged to give special bail to the action of Henry Meade of Somerset County planter present before the said Court and or later for the said Isajah Quaterman that if the said Aaron Lynn shall recover Judgment in the plea afo against the aforesaid Isajah Quaterman or that the said Isajah Quaterman should be therron convicted that then the said Isajah Quaterman shall pay the Judgment of the Court whorugon or render his body to the custody of the sherrif of Somerset County in satisfaction thereof or that he the said Henry Meade will do it for him &c

And the aforesaid Isajah by James Shiley his attorney comes and defends the free and duty when &c and saith that the said Aaron his action afo against him the said Isajah ought not to have and maintain because he saith that on the sixteenth day of June last past and One thousand seven hundred and twenty nine and before the bringing this action he well and faithfully paid to the said Aaron Lynn five pounds Eleven shillings and four pence half penny at Somerset County and within the Jurisdiction of this Court and as to the four pounds three shillings and a penny half pence the residue of the debt in the said declaration specified the said Isajah further saith that he afterwards to wit the sameday and year as aforesaid and before the commencement of this action William Robinson of the County aforesaid tendered unto him the said Aaron the said four pounds three shillings and one penny which said four pounds three shillings and one penny the said Aaron then and there refused to accept of and that the said Isajah is ready to prove and demands Judgment of the said Court if the said Aaron his action afo against him ought to have &c And the aforesaid Aaron says that he by any thing Breached by the said Isajah ought not to be precluded from having and maintaining his action afo against the said Isajah because he says that the said Isajah did not upon the Eighteenth day of June seven hundred and twenty nine pay unto the
