Execution to award in all such Cases and Actions aforesaid according to the Laws Statutes and Ordinances, and in which Paid Actions so to be tried we do constitute Ordain and appoint You the said Samuel Hopkins, William Blanner, John Jones William Fairt John Smith William Stoughton, John Caldwell John Worcester John Hardy James Dashie John Scott Robert King, James Martin and William Lane and none others to be Judges also by these presents we do command the Sheriff of Our said County of Maryland that at the several Courts to be held for Our said County he Give his attendance and cause to come before you or any three or more of you as aforesaid such and so many good and Lawfull men of his County with out of each and Every hundred three of whom the truth of the matter in the premises may be the better known and Enquired of Lastly you shall cause to be brought before you at your said Courts all writs precepts process and Instruments to your Courts and Jurisdiction belonging that the same may be Inspected and by due Course of Law determined Witness our Seal.

Maryland to Charles absolute Lord and Proprietor of the Province of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore &c To William Blanner, John Jones, William Fairt, John Smith, William Stoughton, John Caldwell and John Worcester of Somerset County Gent^rs Greeting we do hereby Authorize and Empower you or either of you to administer the several Oaths appointed by act of Assembly to be taken to the Government as also the Oath of Justice in the oads following vizt.

YOU A.B. do swear that as a Justice of this his Lordship's County Court you will well and truly serve his Lordship and do execute right to all his Majesties Subjects to the best of your Learning and Skill and Cause all Guises forfitures and Imprisementments which shall happen to pass before you, to enter without Recreant you will not debar or hinder the prosecution of Justice or take any Gift or fee for the delaying of Judgment but Justly and truly abear ^{your selfe} so long as you shall continue in the said Office of Justice as aforesaid So help you God.

unto Samuel Hopkins, John Hardy, James Dashie, John Scott, Robert King, James Martin and William Lane of the same County Gent^rs or any of them and You the said Samuel Hopkins, John Hardy, James Dashie, John Scott, Robert King, James Martin and William Lane or any of you having taken the said Oaths are hereby impowered to administer the same to the Justices and Clerks concer-

ningly as they are nominated in the within Commission and we Will that you and every of you having taken the said Oaths do severally subscribe the test and Oath of Abjuration and for so doing this shall be your sufficient Warrant and Authority hereof fail not and where you have the same to doe you are to Certifie the same under your hand, & Seal for Our High Court of Admiralty will be convenient speed witness our dear Brother Benet^r Leon^r Calvert Esq^r Our Lieut^r Generall and Chief Governor in and over this Our Province of Maryland this third day of June in the Seventeenth Year of Our Dominion of Maryland 1731.
