The petition aforesaid being Read and heard — Therefore it is considered by the Court here that — a Commission issue to the aforesaid Robert Hardy as by the petition aforesaid is prayed and that Thomas — Humphrys, James Malmone, Egert King and Joseph Wailes all of Somerset County Gentlemen be Commissioners and execute the same Commission according to Law &c.

It is Ordered by the Court that the Sher. of Somerset County to wit John Burnall Gentleman Return apan-
nicle of Grand Jury immediately to Enquire for the body of Somerset County. Whereupon the Sher. of Somerset

Isaac Weston, whereupon proclamation being made in common form and the Jurors as so as to Impar-
ted and Severally Called over by their names do appear as above, and were sworn and charged and sent out
to consider &c. soon after the Grand Jury as being Imparalled sworn and charged as before returned into
Court, and being severally called over as so to appear, and being asked if they had made any bills of Indict-
ments or agreed on any presentments Return the following Indictments and presentments, Indictment ag^t.
Thomas Duncan, and Eliz^t Chambers and presentments against Bridget Smillie, Ann Heaton, Mary Boister.
Sontky Whittington and Rachel Weston being Content that the Court Should amend form altering no matter of
Substance in them and against the severale persons so as to Indict and presented it is ordered that further
Issue returnable here to next Court. Whereupon the Grand Jury as are discharged and ordered to be allowed
five hundred pounds of tobacco (subjected to deduction) to be paid next Term Court &c.

missioners and execute the same Commission according to Law &c.
