and thirty One pound in Court Lewis Gale who for his Said Lordship in this behalf prosecutes  
and prays here in Court that he will not further prosecute against the afo Mary Windsor ad Miller on the  
presentment afo --- Therefore it is considered by the Court here that the afo Mary Windsor ad Miller  
be quiet and goe home without Day &c

Ordered by the Court here that John Bewans be Overseer in Dorchester hundred with John Dennis J. P. and

Thereupon Command was Given to the Sh. of Somerset County that he should take the Said John
