

Someret & Charles absolute Lord and Proprietary of the provinces of Maryland and avallou Lord Baron of Baltimore &c. To the Sher. of Someret County Greeting we command you that you attach any the Goods and Chattells Rights or Creditts of Robert Ware Late of Someret County planter if they shall be found in your County worth to the value of Eighty four pounds Six Shillings Current money and three thousands One hundred and fifty pounds of tobacco and when you have the same attached or any part hereof the same in your Custody Safe keep so that you have the same before our Justices of the Peace of Someret County to be held at at dwelling from the third Tuesday of June next then and there to be condemned according to act of Assembly to and for the use of a certain Southy Whittington unless his said Robert Ware by himself or attorney shall appear and answer unto the said Southy Whittington in a place of trespass upon the same according to Law and that by Good and Lawfull men of your County which you make known unto the person or persons in whose hands you made the same attachment that he she or they be and appear before our Justices of our County Court to be held at as to the cause if any he she or they have why the same Goods, Chattells Rights or Creditts so attached in his her or their hands Right not to be condemned and Execution thereof had and made according to the form of the act of Assembly in such case made and provided it to him her or them it shall make & how you shall execute this writt that you make known unto our said Justices at the day and place as and have you then and there this writt witness William Blaunor Clerk One of our Justices of our said Court the twenty sixth day of March in the Sixteenth Year of our Dominion & anno domini one thousand Seven hundred eighty six.

At which said third Tuesday of June to wit the fifteenth day of the same month and year One thousand Seven hundred and thirty one being the day of the return of the said writt cometh the said Southy Whittington by Lewis Gale his attorney and the Sher. of Someret County to whom the foregoing writt was directed comes and makes return hereof to the Court here bidered witness To the worshipfull Justices within mentioned I Certifie that I have attached as the Goods and Chattells of the within named Robert Ware to the value of fifty four pounds Sixteen Shillings and three pence as appears by a certain Indenture made and delivered to the same Goods and Chattells to the within named Southy Whittington by so enow John Burne the Clerk

Whereupon the aforesd Southy Whittington by his attorney aforesaid prayeth that upon giving Security according to act of Assembly the Goods and Chattells so aforesaid to the value of fifty four pounds Sixteen Shillings and three pence may be condemned towards Satisfaction unto him the sum of Eighty four pounds Six Shillings Current money and three thousand One hundred and fifty pounds of tobacco.

Thereupon a certain Francis Allen of Someret County Gentleman present before me undertaker for the said Southy Whittington according to act of Assembly that in case the said Robert Ware do at any time appear within a year and day and make all or any part of the said Southy Whittingtons claim against him to be satisfied or otherwise to have been undue before the laying of the attachment and that he make the said Southy Whittington make Satisfaction unto him the said Robert Ware of all or such part thereof as shall be so made appear to be undue or that he the said Francis Allen will do it for him therefore it is ordered that the aforesd Goods and Chattells to the value of fifty four pounds Sixteen Shillings and three pence be condemned as the Rights and Creditts of the aforesd Robert Ware towards Satisfaction unto the said Southy Whittington the aforesd sum of Eighty four pounds Six Shillings and three thousand One hundred and fifty pounds of tobacco and that he have therof Execution.
