

Somerset Co. Charles absolute Lord and Proprietary of the provinces of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore &c. To the Sher. of Somerset County greeting we Command you that you attach any the Goods and Chattels Rights or Credits of Robert Ware Late of Somerset County planter if they shall be found in your Bailly writ to the value of Eighty four pounds Six Shillings Current money and three thousand one hundred and fifty pounds of tobacco and when you have the same attached or any part thereof the same in your Custody safe keep so that you have the same before our Justice of ~~the County~~ County Court of Somerset to be held at at and ending free the third Tuesday of June next then and there to be condemned according to act of assembly to and for the use of a certain Southy Whittington unless the said Robert Ware by himself or attorney shall appear and answer unto the said Southy Whittington in a plea of trespass upon the Case ~~the~~ according to Law and that by Good and Lawfull men of your Bailly writ you make known unto the person or persons in whose hands you made the same attachment that he or they be and appear before our Justice of ~~the County~~ County Court of to be held as aforesaid to show Cause if any he or they have why the same Goods Chattels Rights or Credits so attached in his her or their hands ought not to be condemned and Execution thereof and made according to the form of the act of assembly in such Case made and provided if to him her or them it shall meet & how you shall execute this writ that you make known unto our said Justice at the day and place aforesaid and have you then and there this writ witnessed William Blainor Gent. One of our Justices of our said Court the twentieth day of March in the Sixteenth Year of our Dominion &c. and Dow. One thousand seven hundred & thirty &c.

At which said third Tuesday of June to wit the fifteenth day of the same month and Dow. One thousand seven hundred and thirty one being the day of the Return of the said writ Cometh the said Southy Whittington by Leon Galahis attorney and the Sher. of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writ was directed comes and makes Return thereof to the Court here ordered viz. To the worshipfull Justice within mentioned I Certifie that I have attached as the Goods and Chattels of the within named Robert Ware to the value of fifty four pounds Sixteen Shillings and three pence as appears by a certain Shoduk known unto aforesaid and have delivered the same Goods and Chattels to the within named Southy Whittington &c. so answer John Curran the Sher.

Whereupon the said Southy Whittington by his attorney aforesaid prays that upon giving Security according to act of assembly the Goods and Chattels ^{of said Robt Ware} so as aforesaid attached to the value of fifty four pounds Sixteen Shillings and three pence may be condemned to vend. Satisfying unto him the sum of Eighty four pounds Six Shillings Current money and three thousand one hundred and fifty pounds of tobacco.

Thereupon a certain Francis Allen of Somerset County Gent. sprew out known Court undertaker for the said Southy Whittington according to act of assembly that in Case the said Robert Ware do at any time appear within a year and a day and make all or any part of the said Southy Whittingtons Claim against him to be satisfied or otherwise to have been made before the Laying of the attachment aforesaid that the said Southy Whittington shall make Restitution unto him the said Robert Ware of all or such part thereof as shall be so made appear to be undue & or that he the said Francis Allen will be do it for him so therefore it is considered that the said Goods and Chattels to the value of fifty four ^{the} pounds ^{and} ^{the} ^{sum} ^{of} ^{eighty} ^{four} ^{pounds} ^{six} ^{shillings} ^{and} ^{three} ^{pence} may be condemned as the Rights and Credits of the said Robert Ware towards Satisfying unto the said Southy Whittington the said sum of Eighty four pounds Six Shillings Current money three thousand one hundred and fifty pounds of tobacco and that he have thereof Execution &c.
