Somerset County Gent<sup>r</sup> greeting know ye that we have appoint-  
ed you or any three or two of you to be our commissioners to examine Evidence  
on behalfe of aforesaid Thomas Dashiel of the County aforesaid in relation to the  
bounds of part of a tract of Land lying in the County aforesaid Called Gethsemani  
we therefore require you or any three or two of you at some time and place as  
to you or any three or two of you shall seem convenient you meet on the said Land  
Called Gethsemani you first having taken your oaths on the Holy Evangelist  
of almighty God according to act of Assembly in such case made and provided and  
where cause to come before you any three or two of you all such evidences as  
shall be to you or any three or two of you Nominated by the said complainent or  
Def<sup>r</sup> if any and that you or any three or two of you Examined them upon those  
corporall Oaths to be by you or any three or two of you Administered on the holy  
Evangelist of almighty God in the presence of the said complainent or Def<sup>r</sup> if  
any touching the truth or remembrance of their knowledge on any thing that  
may relate to the cause aforesaid and that reducing the several opposition into  
writing you send the same together with this our commission under your or-  
daining you send the same together with this our commission under your or-  
any three or two of your hands to our County court of Somerset with all  
convenient speed Willm<sup>r</sup> Sam<sup>r</sup> Hopkins Gent<sup>r</sup> chief Justice of our said court  
the Nineteenth day of March in the tenth Year of our Dominion & Anno Domini  
one thousand Seven hundred and twenty five

June the fifteenth day and Dous One thousand Seven Hundred and thirty One came here unto Court George Scott and  
Thomas Humphrys two of the Commissioners above Nominated and made return of the same Commission wherein directed  
with the several affidavits Recd aforesaid vizt on March 1726 came W<sup>r</sup> George Scott before me the subscriber  
one of his Lordships Justices of the peace for Somerset County and was sworn well and truly to execute the within Comis-  
sion according to act of Assembly in that case made and provided Sworn before me James Dashiel

February 25<sup>th</sup> 1726 came the within mentioned Thomas Humphrys before me John Randy one of his Lordships  
Justices of the peace for the County of Somerset and made oath on the Holy Evangelist of almighty God to execute  
the within Commission according to act of Assembly in such case made and provided. J<sup>r</sup> Randy

Maryland Somerset County August the 19<sup>th</sup> day 1726

These are to certify that we the subscribers by virtue of his Lordships Commission to us directed from his Lordships  
Commission to us directed from his Lordships Justices of said County to examine Evidence to the boundary of a tract of Land  
Called Gethsemani for nine hundred acres which tract of Land is in the possession of Christopher Nutt and other sundry  
persons of said County at whose prayer said Commission I had bearing date the 19<sup>th</sup> day of August 1726 according to  
an act of Assembly we did setting our notifications under our hands in Stogursey Parish by the publick Chapple and  
other publick place above thirty days before we mett on said Land and having appointed by our said notifications  
to meet on said Land the twenty fourth day of October 1726 so accordingly mett on the said day bearing summons Wm.  
Geill, Da. Memrie, Thomas Wilson, John More Esq<sup>r</sup> of the Forrest Richard Rider, Daniel Weatherly, Mary Dick  
John Nicholson, Benjamin Wiles, for evidence in the presence of both parties we did proceed and being brought  
by William Geill and the rest of the aforesaid Evidence down to the north side of Quantico Creek by this  
side of same at the more amulberry post Roads which post stands eighty yards to the eastward of a gully
