James Rownd Late of Somerset County Gent executor of the Last Will and Testament of Robert Ogleby decd. was attacked to answer unto Isaac Bredak of a plea of trespass upon the Case & And whereas the Said Isaac by Francis Allen his attorney Complainor that whereas the Said Robert in his Life time vizt the second day of March and Dow. One thousand

Seven hundred and twenty eight at Somerset County and within the Jurisdiction of this Court was by the providence of God afflicted with Sickness at the house of him the Said Isaac in Consideration that he the Said Isaac at the Special Instance and request of the Said Isaac Robert then and there would provide for and nurse the Said Robert in the time of his Sickness, and in case the Said Robert should depart this Life at the house of him the Said Isaac he the Said Isaac would bury him the Said Robert in a Christian like manner the Said Robert then and there in his life to witt the day and Year aforesaid at the day and Year aforesaid at the place aforesaid upon himselfe did assume and to the Said Isaac then and there did faithfully promise that the Said Isaac so much as he the Said Isaac should reasonably deserve for the nursing of him the Said Robert in the time of his Sickness and for all reasonable Damages and Expenses about the Same as also for the funerals Charges and Expenses in and about the burying of him the Said Robert in case of death of him the Said Robert out of the estate of him the Said Robert after the decease of him the Said Robert should be truly and honestly Contented Satisfied and paid and the Said Isaac in fact faith that giving Credit to the promise and assumption of the Said Robert in his Life time so as aforesaid he the Said Isaac and family did well and Diligently attend the Said Robert in the time of his Sickness and also did after the decease of the Said Robert bury the Said Robert in a Christian like Decent manner and that he for the attendance Nursing and trouble of his house and family and the Paying of his bed by the Said Robert and for the funerals Charges and Expenses in burying the Said Robert doth Reasonably deserve to have and receive of the Said James Esq. of the Said Robert the Sum of four pounds Eleven Shillings and two pence Curr. money of Maryland of which the Said James Rownd the thirtieth day of March and Dow. Seventeen hundred & twenty nine had notice by the hands of the Said Isaac had notice vizt at the County and within the Jurisdiction of Nevertheless the Said James the promise and assumption aforesaid of the aforesaid Robert in his Life time so as aforesaid nothing regarding but plotting and fraudulently Intending the Said Isaac in that part Craftily and Subtly to deceive and defraud the aforesaid four pounds Eleven Shillings and two pence out of the Estate of the Said decd. altho' the same to do the Said James by the Said Isaac on the aforesaid thirtieth day of March in the Year Last mentioned and after aforesaid at the County and howe Accounts requested hath not paid or in any sort for the Same Contented hath refused and shall doth refuse and deny whereas the Said Isaac faith he is warr and hath Damage to the Value of nine pounds Currant money of Maryland and thereupon he brings Suit go -
