Therefore it is considered by Consent of the parties aforesaid that the said John Woolten Recover against the said Brent Nuttall his damages to the said five pounds and eleven pence farthing by the said Brent Nuttall in full as Confessed as also two hundred & sixty four pounds of the same for his Costs and Charges to the said John Woolten at his request by the Court here and Consent of the parties as adjudged and the said Brent Nuttall in mercy &c with this &c. he is any more -
