 full as confessed as also two hundred and thirteen pounds of tobacco for his Costs
 and Charges as to the same James at his Request by the Court hereof him about adjudged & was debt in money

Amos Woodward } Command was Given to the Sher. of Somerset County that he should take the said John Donaldson
 of Somerset County merch^t. otherwise called John Donaldson of Somerset County in the
 promise of Maryland merch^t. if he should be found in his bayliwick and him should safe
 keep so that he might have his body before his Lordships Justices of the County Court of Somerset to be hold at dividing
