

June Court 1731 ---- 93

as follows the 2d Somerset County by John Donaldson late of Somerset County merchant otherwise called John Donaldson of Somerset County in the province of Maryland Merchant was comended to answer unto Amos Woodward of a plea that he render unto him forty one pounds Seven Shillings and Six pence current Money which somm he owes and unjustly Detains &c. — And whereupon the same Amos by James Shirley his Attorney saith that whereas the said John the eighth day of July and anno seventeen hundred and twenty eight at Somerset County aforesaid within the Court of this court by his certain Writing obligatory which he the said Amos with the Seal of him the said John sealed hereinto court baring the date whereof is the same day and year did acknowledge himself to be held and firmly bound unto the said Amos in the aforesaid forty one pounds Seven Shill. and Six pence curr. money aforesaid to be paid unto the said Amos when he the said John by him the said Amos should be thereunto required yet he the said John the often thereunto required the said forty one pounds Seven Shill. and Six pence to the said Amos hath not rendered but the same to sum hitherto to render hath denied and still doth deny and justly Detain whereupon he the said Amos saith that he is made worse and hath damage to the value of one hundred pounds like money aforesaid whereupon he brings suit:

In Shirley Alley & Quay & Cldg from Mr. Doe & Rose

A copy of the foregoing Declaration was made and sent to be served on the defendant with the writ in the place aforesaid.

At which said next Court to wit the fifteenth day of November and anno One thousand Seven hundred and Thirtieth being the day of the return of the said Writ against the said Amos Woodward by his attorney aforesaid and the said of Somerset County to whom the foregoing writ was directed Likewise quitted and made the return thereof to the said Clerk endorsed and signed by him and delivered in hand of John Burnall Esq;

And the said John Donaldson by Lewis Hale his attorney &c. comes and defends the same and injury where he and saith that he cannot have the action aforesaid of the aforesaid Amos nor can he say but that the writing Obligatory aforesaid is the deed of the same John nor but that he owes the same Amos the aforesaid forty one pounds Seven Shillings and Six pence curr. money in manner and form as the aforesaid Amos above against him hath declared.

Wherefore it is considered that the aforesaid Amos Woodward recover against the aforesaid John Donaldson his debt aforesaid and his damages by reason of the detaining of the same debt to three hundred & Sixty three pds. of tobacco to the same Amos of his agent by the Court here adjudged with Stay of Execution for six months and a day defendt in money, remanding the office by his attorney Release the penalty trespairing the principal debt and interest until payment be —
