The condition of the above Obligation is Such that wheresoever the County General Court has remitted unto this Court the amount of the Estate of William Slurges decd. wherein it is found that there is a balance due to the above said orphan the sum of twenty pounds Seventeen Shillings and Seven pence currant money.

If therefore the above said Jeremiah Brittingham his heirs Executors or administrators shall and do well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the above named Jacob Slurges the sum of twenty pounds Seventeen Shillings and Seven pence currant money according to act of assembly when he shall arrive at full age to receive the same & then the above Obligation to be void and of none effect otherwise to remain in full force and virtue in Law &c.
