

The said bill was then read the third time, by special order, passed and sent to the House of Delegates.

Mr. Purnell presented the petition of the Trustees of Buckingham Academy,

Which was read and referred to Messrs. Purnell, Goldsborough and Hambleton.

On motion of Mr. Schley,

The bill entitled, an act to authorise and direct the levy court of Frederick county, to levy a sum of money for the enlargement and repair of the court house in said county, was read the third time, by special order, passed and sent to the house of delegates.

On motion of Mr. Ricaud,

The bill entitled, an act supplemental to the act entitled, an act for the relief of the heirs of Jane White, late of the city of Baltimore, was taken up for consideration, it was read the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

On motion of Mr. Tidball,

Leave was granted to Messrs. Tidball, Ricaud and Wright, to prepare and report a bill to be entitled, an act to repeal the second section of an act entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act concerning the amendment of judicial proceedings, passed at December session 1833 chapter 276.

Mr. Goldsborough from the committee on colored population, to which was referred the bill entitled, an act for the relief of Harriet Green of Montgomery county, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second time.

The clerk of the House of Delegates delivered the following bills:

A bill entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act to incorporate a Bank to be called by the name of the Bank of Saulsbury,

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on corporations and joint stock companies.

A bill entitled, an act to confirm an act entitled, an act to provide for an alteration in the constitution so far as relates to the division of the sixth election district in Worcester county,

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Purnell, Hambleton and Goldsborough.
