

MONDAY, January 30, 1837.

The Senate met. Present the same Senators as on Saturday. The proceedings of Saturday were read.

The resolution in favor of James Vane, assented to by the Senate on Saturday, and

The bill entitled, an act providing for the appointment of commissioners to divide Carroll county into election districts, passed by the Senate on Saturday with certain amendments, were returned, and

The bill entitled, a supplement to an act authorising Henry Shafer, George Shafer and Henry I. Shafer, to distribute their estate by lot, passed at December session 1834, chapter 104, and

The bill entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act to appropriate a part of the school fund belonging to Frederick county to the purposes therein mentioned, and for other purposes, also severally passed by the Senate on Saturday, were sent to the house of delegates.

Mr. Hilleary from the committee on revolutionary claims, to which was referred the resolution in favor of Anne Wright, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second and by special order the third time, assented to and returned to the House of Delegates.

Mr. Bowie from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to change the terms of Prince George's county court, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendment,

Which was read and assented to:

At the end of the first section add the following words as an amendment thereto:

"And all writs original, mesne or judicial, and other process of said court, shall be returnable in conformity with the provisions of this act."

The bill was then read the second and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the House of Delegates.

Mr. Bowie, from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act for the relief of Martha Riley of Montgomery county, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second, and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.
