

Which was read and with the enclosures, referred to the consideration of the house of delegates.

On motion of Mr. Schley,

Leave was granted to Messrs. Schley, Brown and Jones, to prepare and report a bill to be entitled, an act to authorise the sheriff of Frederick county, and the sheriff of Baltimore county respectively, in certain cases, to execute writs and other process, serve subpoenas and perform other official acts in the respective portions of Baltimore county, and of Carroll county which were heretofore included within their several bailiwicks.

Mr. Brown from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act supplemental to an act entitled, an act providing for the appointment of commissioners to divide Carroll county into election districts, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the House of Delegates.

Mr. Tidball from the committee to which had been committed the bill entitled, an act to regulate the right of voting by the stockholders in the several incorporated institutions in this state, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration and had instructed him to ask leave to withdraw said bill in order that they might report a bill in its stead—accordingly leave was so granted.

Mr. Tidball then reported a bill entitled, an act to regulate the right of voting by the Stockholders in the several incorporated institutions in this State,

Which was read the first time.

The bill entitled, an act to enable Theodorick Bland, to bring certain slaves into this state, was read the third time, rejected and returned to the house of delegates.

The bill entitled, an act to authorise and empower Elizabeth Duvall, executrix of Grafton B. Duvall of Anne Arundel county, to sell and dispose of her negro man William Philips, who is a slave only for a term of years, beyond the limits of this state, was read the third time, rejected and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Bowie from the committee on internal improvement, to which was referred the bill entitled, a further supplement to the act entitled, an act to incorporate the Delaware and Maryland Rail Road Company, reported favorably thereon.
