

The bill entitled, an act to authorise Thomas S. Carter and William F. Chilton, of Caroline county, to alter and change a road therein mentioned, and

The bill entitled, a further supplement to the act entitled, an act to incorporate the Delaware and Maryland Rail Road Company, also severally passed by the Senate on yesterday, were returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Kent from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to allow Thomas Bruce, former sheriff of Prince George's county further time to complete his collections, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second, and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

The Senate resumed the consideration of the unfinished business of yesterday, being the bill entitled, an act relating to the Legislative Department of the Government of this State, and to repeal so much of the Constitution and Form of Government as may be inconsistent with its provisions.

The bill was being further read the second time.

Mr. Kent offered the following amendment,

Which was read and dissented from:

In the 3d line of the 2nd section, strike out the word 'one' and insert the word 'two.'

Mr. Ricaud moved to strike out the 3d section and insert as follows:

'Section 3d, And be it enacted, that the Senate shall be chosen in the following manner; all persons qualified to vote for county delegates, shall on the Monday of 1838, and on the same day in every fifth year forever thereafter, elect by a majority of votes, two persons from their respective counties, to be electors of the Senate, and all persons qualified to vote for delegates for the city of Baltimore, shall on the Monday of 1838, and on the same day in every fifth year forever thereafter, elect by a majority of votes, two persons for the said city to be electors of Senate, the said election to be held in the same manner as the election of delegates for said city.'
