At the end of the 1st section add:

'And provided also, that the amount which may accrue from the additionall two cents, allowed by this act for the transportation of passengers, and the amount which shall accrue from the excess of the charge for the transportation of goods, wares, merchandize and other property, allowed by this act, over and above the charge allowed for transportation and tolls by the original act of incorporation, mentioned by its title in this section, shall be considered, with reference to the construction and application of the ninth section of an act entitled, "an act for the promotion of internal improvement," passed at December session eighteen hundred and thirty five, chapter three hundred and ninety five, as profits of the work, and shall be specially applicable, together with all other profits of the work, for the fulfilment of the guarantee to the state, for the payment of interest on the amount of money, if any, which shall be paid to said company, under and by virtue of said act, without any deduction or abatement for expenses or disbursements of any kind to be incurred by said company, or any other of the contracts or engagements of said company.'

On motion of Mr. Bowie,

The said bill and amendment were ordered to lie on the table.

The bill entitled, an act to regulate the right of voting by the Stockholders in the several incorporated institutions in this State, was taken up for consideration.

Add to the bill the following section:

'And be it enacted, that this act shall not apply to Frederick county.'
