was referred the bill entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act relating to insolvent debtors in the city and county of Baltimore, passed at December session 1816, chapter 221, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second time.

Mr. Goldsborough from the committee on colored population to which was referred the petition of Peregrine Rhoades; and the petition of Samuel M. Sutton and wife, reported that the committee had had said petitions under consideration and were of opinion the prayers therein contained ought not to be granted,

Which was read and concurred in.

Mr. Cottman from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, a further supplement to an act entitled, an act to regulate the inspection of salted fish, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second, and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Hambleton from the committee on divorces, to which was referred the petition of Thomas Hadley, reported that the committee had had said petition under consideration and were of opinion the prayer therein contained ought not to be granted,

Which was read and concurred in.

Mr. Beckett from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to lay off a public landing at the farm called Retirement, near Leonard's-town, St. Mary's county, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration and were of opinion it ought not to pass.

It was read the second and by special order the third time, rejected and returned to the House of Delegates.

Mr. Ricaud from the committee on judicial proceedings, to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to continue in force the acts of assembly which would expire with the present session of the General Assembly,

And the bill entitled, an act for the relief of the heirs and legal representatives of Peter Orndorff, reported fa-

vorably thereon.

They were severally read the second and by special order the third time passed and returned to the house of delegates.
