Mr. Ricaud from the committee on corporations and joint stock companies, to which was referred the bill entitled, an act supplemental to an act to incorporate the Cumberland Hotel Company in Cumberland, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendment,

Which was read and assented to:

Add as the 4th section:

“And be it enacted, that nothing in this act or in the act to which this is a supplement, shall be construed to confer any banking privilege on said company.”
