The following amendments were read and assented to. After the word "affidavit," insert "or affirmation."

At the end of the bill add:

"Which oath or affirmation shall be administered by, and taken before some one member of the levy court or county commissioners, as the case may be, who are hereby fully authorised and empowered to administer said oath or affirmation."

On motion of Mr. Brown,

The following amendment was read and assented to:

'Section 2. And be it enacted, that it shall be lawful for the levy court, or the county commissioners, as the case may be, to have free access to the record of the registers of wills and clerks of county courts without charge, for the purpose of examining the accounts of said registers of wills or clerks of county courts, so far as regards their charges against their respective counties.'

On motion of Mr. Tidball.

The bill was then ordered to lie on the table.

Mr. Ricaud from the committee on judicial proceedings, to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to authorise the orphans court of Harford county, to order a sale of part of the estate of John F. Wheeler, deceased, for the support and education of his children, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration and were of opinion it ought not to pass.

It was read the second time.
