

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on colored population.

Mr. Jones from the committee on corporations and joint stock companies to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Williamsport Manufacturing Company, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendments,

Which were read and assented to:

1st section 7th line, between the words 'same' and 'style' insert the word 'name.'

Same section last line, strike out the word 'fifty' and insert 'seventy five.'

3d section 3d line, strike out after the word 'liable,' 'for the same' and insert 'for such excess.'

3d section 4th line, after the word 'action' insert 'or actions, suit or suits.'

3d section 7th line, after the word 'execution' insert 'which execution shall have all the force and effect as at common law in other cases.'

5th section 5th line, strike out the words 'by ballot.'

8th section 6th line, after the word 'estates' insert 'except the said stockholders be made liable as directors as hereinbefore provided for.'

The bill was then read the second and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Brown submitted the following message,

We have received your message proposing to proceed at 12 o'clock, M. to the appointment of a proper person to be recommended to the Governor to be commissioned as register of wills for Carroll county, and concur therein.
