On motion of Mr. Tidball, (two thirds of the Senate concurring) the following amendments were read and assented to:

After the word "claimed" in the 16th line, insert the words "that the share or shares, which he, she or it offers to vote, have not been transferred to him, her or it, for the purpose of enabling him, her or it to vote thereon at the said or any other election, and that he, she or it has not contracted to sell or transfer the said share or shares upon any condition, agreement or understanding, in relation to his, her or its manner of voting at the same or any other election.

2. Strike out the 3d section.

The bill was then read the third time and passed.

The Senate adjourned until Monday morning ten o'clock.

MONDAY, February 20, 1837.

The Senate met. Present the same Senators as on Saturday. The proceedings of Saturday were read.

The bill entitled, an act to regulate the right of voting by the Stockholders in the several incorporated institutions in this state, passed by the Senate on Saturday, was sent, and

The bill entitled, an act to alter, change and amend a certain road in Allegany county,

The bill entitled, an act to authorise the laying out and opening a road in Allegany county, therein mentioned,

The bill entitled, an act for the promotion of education in Allegany county, by means of the poor school fund of said county, and

The bill entitled, an act to alter and change part of the divisional line between the fourth and fifth election districts in Dorchester county, also severally passed by the Senate on Saturday, were returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Jones from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act relating to the City Dock in the city of Baltimore, reported favorably thereon.
