

The question being upon assenting to said amendment,

Mr. Jones submitted the following as a substitute:

Add at the end of 1st section—

And provided also, that the amount which may accrue from the additional charge allowed by this act for the transportation of passengers, and the amount which shall accrue from the excess of the charge for the transportation of goods, wares and merchandise and other property allowed by this act, over and above the charge allowed for transportation and tolls, by the original act of incorporation, and the act entitled, an act for the promotion of internal improvement, passed at December session, 1835, chapter 395, or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be applicable to the fulfilment of the guarantee to the State, for the payment of interest on the amount of money if any, which shall be paid from time to time, to the said company, under and by virtue of said act, passed at December session 1835, chapter 395.

Provided nevertheless, and be it enacted, that this last proviso shall not take effect until after 3 years from the payment of each instalment as provided in the act entitled, an act for the promotion of internal improvement, passed at December session 1835, chapter 395.
