The bill was then read the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Kent, from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, anact for the relief of Joseph Wood

former sheriff of Calvert county,

The bill entitled, an act to lay out and open a road from the gate opposite the residence of Caleb White, in Anne Arundel county, to the mill owned by Richard W. Higgins in said county, and

The bill entitled, an act to extend the time of Isaac G. Magruder late collector of Prince George's county, to complete his collections, reported favorably thereon.

They were severally read the second and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the House

of Delegates.

Mr. Goldsborough from the committee on colored population to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to authorise Eleanor R. Contee and Philip A. L. Contee. guardians of Benjamin Contee, of Charles county, to introduce certain slaves for life into this State, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the House of Delegates.

The bill entitled, an act to repeal an act to establish magistrates courts in the several counties of this State, and to prescribe their jurisdiction, so far as the same relates to Kent county, was read the third time, passed and sent to the house of delegates

Mr. Tidball presented the petition of sundry citizens of Washington county, for an act vesting the appointment of certain officers of said county in the Governor and Coun-

cil, in certain contingencies.

Which was read and referred to Messrs. Tidball, Jones and Hilleary.

On motion of Mr. Wright,

Leave was granted to the committee on judicial proceedings, to prepare and report a bill to be entitled, an act supplemental to an act relating to the records of conveyances in the several counties of this State, passed at December session 1833, chapter 88.

The Senate adjourned until to morrow morning, 10 o'clock.
