

TUESDAY, February 28, 1837.

The Senate met. Present the same Senators as on yesterday. The proceedings of yesterday were read.

Mr. Jones presented the petition of Mary Wills, to be placed on the pension roll,

Which was read and referred to the consideration of the House of Delegates.

Mr. Jones from the committee to which was referred the resolution requesting the Governor to issue a commission to John Baumgartner, as register of wills for Carroll county, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second and by special order the third time, assented to and returned to the House of Delegates.

Mr. Bowie from the committee on judicial proceedings, to which was referred the bill entitled, an act relating to limited partnerships in this State, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second time.

The bill entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act to unite Middletown, Keller's addition to Middletown; Grove's addition to Middletown, and Wise's addition to Middletown, into one by the name of Middletown, and incorporate the same, passed at December session 1833; chapter 145, was read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
