Which was read and referred to Messrs. Brown, Jones and Cottman.

The clerk of the House of Delegates delivered the following resolutions,

A resolution directing the clerk of Harford county court to deliver to William B. Stevenson certain acts of Assembly,

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Brown, Jones and Cottman.

A resolution relative to certain militia officers,

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on the militia.

Also the following bill:

A bill entitled, an act providing for the appointment of clerks of the several county courts, the clerks of the Courts of Appeals for the Eastern and Western Shores, the clerk of Baltimore city court and the Registers of wills in the several counties of this state,

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Schley, Wright, Beckett, Brown, Hambleton, and Bowie.

Mr. Purnell from the committee to which was referred the petition of the trustees of Buckingham academy, reported a bill entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act to incorporate the Buckingham academy in Worcester county, passed at December session 1813, chapter 13,

Which was read the first and by special order, the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

It was accordingly engrossed, and

On motion of Mr. Purnell,

Read the third time by special order, passed and sent to the house of delegates.

Mr. Tidball from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to establish a public ferry across the Potomac river at Hancock, reported favorably thereon,

It was read the second, and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Tidball from the committee to which was referred the petition of sundry citizens of Washington county, reported a bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Washington county Savings Institution.
