The following amendment was read and dissented from: In the 2nd and 3d lines of the 1st section, strike out the words "a vinculo matrimonii" and insert the words "a mensa et thoro."

The bill was then read through the second and by special order the third time passed and returned to the

house of delegates.

Mr. Brown presented three petitions from sundry citizens of Baltimore county, for the repeal of the act of Assembly establishing the commissioners of the tax in said county,

Which were severally read and referred to Messrs,

Brown, Jones and Tidball.

Mr. Jones from the committee to which the leave was granted, reported a bill entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act for making certain roads in Baltimore and Harford counties.

Which was read the first time.

The bill entitled, an act supplemental to an act relating to the records of conveyances in the several counties of this State, passed at December session 1833, chapter 88, was being read the second time, when

On motion of Mr. Hilleary,

The following amendment was read and assented to: In the last line of the 2nd section, strike out "eighteen and three quarters," and insert "ten."

On motion of Mr. Cottman,

The following amendment was read.

In the last line of the bill, after the word "Baltimore," insert the word "Somerset."

On motion of Mr. Brown,

Said amendment was amended by adding the words "and Carroll."

The amendment as amended was then dissented from.

The bill was then read through, and

The question put on ordering it to be engrossed, and determined in the negative.

So the bill was rejected.

Mr. Brown from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled. An act to amend the constitution and form of government of the State of Maryland, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration, and
