Sec. 24. And be it enacted, that in all elections for governor, the city of Annapolis shall be deemed and taken as part of Anne Arundel county, in the same manner as in elections for electors of President and Vice President.

Sec. 25. And be it enacted, that if this act shall be confirmed by the General Assembly, after a new election of delegates in the first session after such new election agreeably to the provisions of the Constitution and form of Government, then and in such case this act, and the alterations and amendments of the Constitution therein contained, shall be taken and considered, and shall constitute and be valid, as a part of said Constitution and form of Government; any thing in the said Constitution and form of Government to the contrary notwithstanding.
