

On motion of Mr. Brown,

The amendments heretofore assented to, were reconsidered.

On motion of Mr. Purnell,

The said amendments were amended by inserting after the word 'census' where it severally occurs in the 17th and 25th lines of the 8th section, the words 'for the year 1840.'

On motion of Mr. Brown,

The said amendments were further amended by striking out all the 9th section after the word 'county.'

The said amendments were then assented to, and

On motion of Mr. Brown,

The bill was ordered to lie on the table.

Mr. Tidball from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act authorising the levy court of Frederick county in their discretion, to levy a sum of money to build a bridge over Catoctin creek on the public road leading from Jefferson via. Frederick Kemp's mill, and intersecting the Petersville and Middletown road, and

The bill entitled, an act supplemental to the act entitled; an act to blend Newtown, (Trap,) and New Freedom in Frederick county, into one by the name of Jefferson, and to establish boundaries of lots by commissioners, and to incorporate the same, passed February 6th, 1832, reported favorably thereon.

They were severally read the second and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Tidball from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, a further additional supplement to the act entitled, an act to alter and change the name of Elizabethtown in Washington county, to Hagerstown, and to incorporate the same, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendment,

Which was read and assented to.

In the 3d line of the 2nd section, after the word 'bounds' insert the words 'except the power of taxation.'

The bill was then read the second and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.
