In the 4th line, after the word "and," strike out the word "permanently."

In the 21st line of the 10th section, after the word "forty," insert the words "or any future census."

On motion of Mr. Cottman,

The following amendment to said amendments was read and assented to.

In the 21st line of the 10th section after the word "taken" insert the words, "and forever thereafter."

On motion of Mr. Tidball,

The following amendment to said amendments was read and assented to,

In the 24th line of the 10th section, after the word "Annapolis," strike out the residue of the section, and insert the words "by the said 9th section of this act."
