

On motion of Mr. Brown,
The following amendment to said amendments was read and assented to.

In the 5th line in the 3d section, after the word "eight" strike out the words "and in every sixth year forever thereafter."

On motion of Mr. Hambleton,
The following amendment to the amendments was read and assented to.

In the 14th, 15th, and 16th lines of the 3d section, strike out after the word "for" the words "six years and until the election of a new Senator and the qualification of a quorum of its members" and insert the words "two, four, or six years, according to the classification of a quorum of its members."

On motion of Mr. Jones,
The following amendment to the said amendments was read and assented to.

In the 6th and 7th lines strike out the words "or in case the President of the Senate shall become governor."

On motion of Mr. Tidball,
The bill and amendments were ordered to lie on the table.

On motion of Mr. Cottman,
The bill entitled An act to establish a line between Carroll and Baltimore counties was read the third time by special order, passed, and sent to the house of Delegates.

The clerk of the house of delegates delivered the following bills.

A bill entitled An act to authorize the Treasurer for the Western Shore to sell the State's right to subscribe for five thousand shares of capital stock of the Merchants' bank of Baltimore and for other purposes, which was read the first and by special order the second time.

A bill entitled an additional supplement to the act for the relief of sundry insolvent debtors, which was read the first time and referred to the committee on insolvency.
