The bill was then read through, and ordered to be en-

grossed for a third reading.

Mr. Jones from the committee on corporations and joint stock companies to which was referred the bill entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act to tneorporate a bank to be called by the name of the bank of Salisbury, reported thut the committee had had said bill under consideration and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendment,

Which was read and assented to:

Add as 7th section:

Sec. 7. And be it enacted, that this charter is hereby continued and extended to the year eighteen hundred and fifty-five, and until the end of the session of the General Assembly thereafter.

The bill was then read the second and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the house

of delegates.

Mr. Jones from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to authorise the commissioners of the town of Havre de Grace, to convey to the Baltimore and Port Deposit Rail Road Company, a part of St. Clair street, in said town, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second and by special order the third

time, passed and returned to the house of delegate.

The clerk of the House of Delegates delivered the foalowing message:

By the House of Delegates

March 9th, 1837.

Gentlemen of the Senate,

We herewith return to your honorable body a bill entitled, an act to ascertain the allowance of the Sheriff of Somerset county for keeping prisoners in gaol, and to provide for the maintenance of debtors actually confined in prison: and respectfully request that the amendments of your honorable body may be reconsidered and withdrawn.
