The said bill was then read and passed.

The clerk of the house of delegates also delivered a bill entitled, a supplement to an act to incorporate the Hamilton Bank, passed at December session 1835, chapter 320,

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on finance.

Mr. Jones from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act relating to coroners in the city and county of Baltimore, and

The bill entitled, an act for the relief of William McComas, one of the collectors of Harford county, reported favorably thereon.

They were severally read the second and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

On motion of Mr. Brown,

The bill entitled, an act to provide for the erection of a bridge over the Great Falls of Gunpowder at Tyson's mill in Baltimore county, was taken up for consideration.

It was being read the second time, when

On motion of Mr. Cottman,

It was amended as follows:

In the seventh line of the first section, strike out the word 'ways.' In the same line, after the word 'road,' strike out the words 'or roads.'

The bill was then read through the second and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Purnell from the committee on finance, to which was referred the resolution relative to certain militia fines, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second and by special order the third time and assented to.

Mr. Tidball from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, a supplement to an act to limit the sitting of the commissioners of the tax in Montgomery county, passed at December session 1835, chapter 34, reported favorably thereon.
