FRIDAY, March 10, 1837.

The Senate met. Present the same Senators as on yesterday. The proceedings of yesterday were read.

The resolutions relative to certain militia fines, assented to by the Senate on yesterday, and

The bill entitled, an act to authorise the Treasurer of the Western Shore to sell the State's right to subscribe for five thousand shares of the capital stock of the Merchants Bank of Baltimore and for other purposes, and

The bill entitled, a supplement to an act to limit the sitting of the commissioners of the Tax in Montgomery county, passed at December session 1835, chapter 34, severally passed by the Senate on yesterday, were returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Brown from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act for building a bridge over Deer creek, at or near William Pyles' Saw mill in Harford county, reported favorably thereon.

Mr. Wright from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act for the protection of Oysters in the waters of the Eastern Shore of this State, passed at December session 1831, ch. 249, so far as relates to the waters bordering on Queen Anne's county, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendment,
