Also, the following bills:

A bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Union Bank of Allegany,

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on Finance.

A bill entitled, an act to grant a donation to the Manchester academy in Carroll county,

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on finance.

And returned the bill which originated in the Senate, entitled, an act to authorize the owner or owners of any mill, factory, distillery, quarry or limekiln situated within the distance of five hundred yards from any rail road now made, or which may hereafter be constructed; to apply to the county court, the levy court or to the commissioners of the county as the case may be, to lay out and open a private road or way from such mill, factory, distillery, quarry or kiln to the most convenient place for intersecting such rail road, endorsed, "will pass."

Also returned the bill, which originated in the Senate, entitled, an act to regulate the right of voting by the stockholders in the several incorporated institutions in this State, endorsed 'will pass with the proposed amendments.'

Which amendments were read and, and were as follows:

On motion of Mr. Tidball,

The bill and amendments were referred to the committee on corporations.

That whenever five or more of the stockholders of any private corporation created by this State, at least thirty days prior to an election for managers, directors or other officers of any such corporation, elected by the stockholders thereof, shall give notice in writing of their intention to canvass the votes which may be given at the next ensuing election thereof, by a notice delivered at the usual place of business thereof, to the President, Cashier,
