It was read the second and by special order the third

time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Purnell from the committee on finance, to which was referred the resolution relative to repairs of the court house of Talbot county, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second and by special order the third time, assented to and returned to the house of delegates.

On motion of Mr. Purnell,

The bill entitled, a supplement to the act to incorporate the Hamilton Bank, passed at December session 1835, chapter 320, was read the third time by special order,

passed and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Cottman from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act for the relief of James Polk, register of wills for Somerset county, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendment,

Which was read and assented to.

In the 3d line after the word 'sureties,' insert the words 'on or before the first day of May next, and not afterwards.'

The bill was then read the second and by special order the third time passed and returned to the house

of delegates.

Mr. Schley from the committee on the Library, to which was referred the resolution authorising the Librarian to procure the works of Sir George Calvert,

The resolution authorising the Librarian to prepare a new catalogue of the books belonging to the Library, and

The resolution in favor of Worcester county court, re-

ported favorably thereon.

They were severally read the second and by special order the third time, assented to and returned to the house

of delegates.
