A bill entitled an act to invest the State's share of the surplus revenue of the United States and for other purposes,

And a bill entitled an act to incorporate the Havre de Grace Bank,

Which were severally read the first time and referred to the committee on finance.

A bill entitled an act to incorporate the St. Martin's canal and navigation company,

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on internal improvement.

On motion of Mr. Schley,

The bill entitled an act to change the divisional line between Frederick county and Carroll county, as therein mentioned, and to alter the constitution and form of gov-
